Two staff members of SMMS were the beneficiaries of Global ADE's ongoing partnership with Kids Play International (KPI). **Chanraksmeay "Raksmeay" Chey**, Sports Instructor; and **Sereyroth "Roth" Maing**, Morality Teacher; are part-time coaches for KPI. Due to their commitment and hard work, these teachers were selected along with other coaches to travel to Park City, Utah, where they participated in a week-long training and team building.

This cross-cultural exchange was funded through the Sports Diplomacy Division of the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs. This International Sports Programming Initiative uses sports to help underserved youth around the world develop important leadership skills, achieve academic success, promote tolerance and respect for diversity, and contribute to their home and host communities.

KPI conducted this coaching workshop using interactive games and sporting activities, which provided these coaches with opportunities to learn and apply new techniques to become better coaches. Additionally, KPI shared their Fair Play foundational skills of respect and moral courage to help the coaches promote gender equity and build better relationships with the youth that they coach. KPI provides skills to the coaches that are highly transferrable in the classroom, at work, home and in the community.
